The Ethel Harris Entrance Scholarship is offering \$10,000 entrance scholarships to new Glendon students. Each award seeks to bring students from Quebec together with students from Ontario and other Canadian provinces to pursue university studies in a bilingual, liberal arts environment.

These scholarships will be awarded to selected applicants newly admitted to Glendon who:

- ✓ are residents of Quebec
- ✓ are entering Glendon as new students who will study full time
- ✓ demonstrate high academic achievement (minimum 80%)
- ✓ demonstrate community involvement, leadership and volunteerism

To be considered for this award:

- ✓ write a personal letter illustrating your qualifications
- ✓ enclose a copy of your resumé
- ✓ Write an essay answering the following questions:

How does a knowledge of both of the country's official languages contribute to understanding contemporary Canada? How can studying at Glendon help you meet your personal and academic goals? (1200 words)
