- BSc programs have heavy science requirements - Minimal room for electives. ***Be careful!***
- If you are taking chemistry for General Education, these courses will need to be completed at Keele campus (SC/CHEM 1000 3.0, SC/CHEM 1001 3.0). They can be tricky to fit into your schedule, so try to complete them as early as possible.
- You have a mandatory course that runs in Summer - GL/BIOL 3000 3.0. Take this course after completing GL/BIOL 2300 3.0 General Ecology.
- You need to take at least one major course in French - GL/BIOL 2203 6.0 or GL/BIOL 2205 6.0. Not ready to take BIOL courses in French? Work on your French first with FSL and take them in a later year. They aren't prerequisites for other courses.
