



## CO-OP WORK PERMIT

IMGR 2 ENGL

As part of the dual degree program in iBA/BBA International Studies and Business Administration, you will have to do an internship which will count towards the course GL/ILST 4300. Therefore, in addition to your study permit, you will need a co-op work permit.

<b>Who?</b>	All emlyon <b>business school</b> students coming to Glendon, York University, in the dual degree program.
<b>When?</b>	To avoid delays in the start of your internship, you should apply for the co-op work permit at the same time as your study permit, before coming to Canada.
<b>How?</b>	It is recommended that you apply online.
<b>Processing time?</b>	The processing time varies by country.
