Students who go on exchange in France can benefit from the medical insurance and it is free of charge. This insurance reimburses you for 30 to 70% of your expenses.

Justificatifs à fournir :

- A piece of ID (ID card, passport, ...)
- Enrolled in a higher education institution for the given academic year
- Banking information, which will enable you to receive your reimbursements (French bank)
- A legal document required to create your identification number (also known as “social security number”).
The legal documents that are accepted are:
 - a copy of your birth certificate
 - a copy of the birth certificate of kin (or any document provided by the consulate)
 - a family record book
 - a marriage certificate
- Finally, for foreign students, a residency permit must be provided. Students must have a long-stay visa, provided that he has been subject to procedures from the French Immigration Office (OFII), that is, the students must live in France for the whole academic year.
