ACAD 2 ENGL

Guiding principles:

- You must have completed and obtained the results of your Language Assessment Test before you can complete this step.
- You have to take the majority of your classes on the Glendon campus (bilateral agreement with your home university).
- Your list of courses must correspond to your study period at Glendon:
 - Fall (F) September to December (3.00 credits courses only)
 - Winter (W) January to April (3:00 credits courses only)
 - Year (Y) September to April (3.00 and/or 6.00 credits courses only)
- [You can not take a 6.00 credits course if you are coming for one semester only.](#)
- Equivalences: 30 Canadian credits = 60 ECTS.

How to read a course code:

Example : GL/ECON 3245

- GL: This course is offered on the Glendon campus. Please note however that some courses can be offered on the Keele campus, even though there is the code GL, simply because this course is cross listed with another department at Keele. The course location will confirm the campus on which is course will be taught.
- ECON: This course is offered by the Economics department.
- 3245: The first digit, 3, means that it is a third-year course.

Steps to follow:

1. Connect to the link in the [Enrolment Guide](#) and choose the courses you would like to register.
2. Have your course approved by your home university and confirm that you have completed the prerequisites for these courses.
3. Contact the Glendon Departments which offer the courses you are interested in enrolling and obtain the permission to register (please see department contact list below). Indicate that you are an exchange student with your name and your York University's student number.
4. Enroll in the timing which was given by the department and please stick to it otherwise you will have to resubmit a request.
