



TRANSPORTS IN TORONTO

Transports

Although Toronto is a big city, it's easy to navigate! Toronto has four transportation systems: subway, streetcar, train and bus. These modes of transportation are operated by the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) and Metrolinx (Go Transit).

How to get to Glendon from the airport?

1. Taxi / UBER	York University, Glendon Campus 2275 Bayview Avenue, Toronto Ontario, M4N 3M6, Canada <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cost: Approx. \$65 • Duration: 45 minutes to 1 hour
2. Bus (TTC)	Go to TTC Trip Planner to get the itinerary. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cost: \$3.25 (cash) • Duration: Approx. 2 hours
3. Train (UP Express) + Bus (TTC)	Check out the UP Express website. You will be able to purchase your ticket online upfront or upon arrival in Toronto. We advise you to stop at Union Station and from there take the subway to Lawrence Station (see TTC Trip Planner from there). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cost: \$12.35 (train) + \$3.25 (bus) • Duration: Approx. 1h30mins

PRESTO card

During your first week in Toronto, we recommend that you buy a PRESTO card. With this card, you will be able to travel in most Toronto transport systems without having to buy tokens or tickets for each trip. For more information, click [here](#).
