How do I earn Participation Points for my Spanish Courses?

- ⇒ *Students are encouraged to attend all SRC activities and participation in each activity can earn Participation Points.*
- ⇒ *There are three levels of Language Workshops and further Cultural Activities will be announced throughout the year.*
- ⇒ *Language Workshops run for 8 weeks each semester and weekly attendance is required. Up to 2 absences are permitted to still earn the Participation Points for each workshop.*

How many Participation Points can I earn?

- ⇒ *Each semester of each Workshop can earn students 2 Participation Points (maximum of 4 Points per year).*
- ⇒ *Students can apply up to 2 Participation Points per semester, per course; this means one can either apply 2 points each term to a 6.0-credit course for a total of 4 points for that one course or apply 2 points to two different 3.0-credit courses for a total of 4 points across both courses, whether the two courses are taught in the same semester or not.*

To what courses can my Participation Points be applied?

- ⇒ *To any course that counts toward the Hispanic Studies Major or Minor (i.e. Program courses).*
- ⇒ *Participation Points cannot be applied to courses that are unique to either the Certificate in Spanish-English Translation or the Certificate in Spanish for Business & Professional Communication. If you are not sure whether your course counts toward the Hispanic Studies Program or these Certificates (some courses count toward both), please ask your professor.*

Please note the following conditions:

- It is the responsibility of each student to sign in upon arrival at the Spanish Resource Centre to register their participation.
- Once the student has completed the attendance requirements (as explained above), they must send an email to the SRC Coordinator (src@glendon.yorku.ca) specifying the workshop they have attended and which Spanish course they would like the extra participation points to be added to. **Please be sure to do this in a timely manner.**
- After checking that the student accomplishes the attendance requirements, the SRC Coordinator will notify Spanish professors of which students have earned extra Participation Points.
- **Students cannot use the Participation Points to pass a failed course.**
