

**SRC Participation Points (2019-2020)****Glendon Campus – Department of Hispanic Studies**

The Department of Hispanic Studies encourages our students to participate in the Spanish Language Workshops organized in coordination with the Spanish Resource Centre, and to attend the screenings of our Hispanic Film Festival. In addition to the academic benefits that they will obtain, students will be granted Participation Points for their academic courses by actively participating in SRC's activities. Please note the following conditions:

- Workshops have a maximum capacity of 10 students.
- It is the responsibility of the student to sign the attendance list during every workshop or film screening session.
- Once the student has completed the attendance requirements, he/she must send an email to the SRC Coordinator (src@glendon.yorku.ca) specifying the activity he/she has attended and which course he/she wants the points to be added to. **Please be sure to do this in a timely manner.**
- After chequing that the student accomplishes the attendance requirements, the SRC Coordinator will forward a Participation Points list of students to each of the professors of the participating courses.
- Students are encouraged to attend all of the SRC activities, but they will only receive a maximum of 6 Participation Points. Students cannot use more than 3 Participation Points for each course.
- **Students cannot use the Participation Points to pass a failed course.**
- This program does not apply to students of the Certificate in Spanish-English Translation.
